## Checklist

Quick overview on how to prepare for your professional photoshoot



Turn off all lights
Open all curtains and shades
Make beds with freshly ironed and tucked bedding
Remove towels, stuffed animals, bed runners, flowers, and any other additional decorative items from beds.
Straighten and align cushions, and pillows on furniture
Arrange and fold blankets
Clear the clutter from all surfaces (kitchen counters, bathroom vanity, hide visible wires and electrical cords)
Remove all family portraits, personal items and kids toys
Remove BBQ and pool covers

# **Styling Tips**

Step by step explanation on how to prepare your home for our professional photographer



### Let's get your home ready for photography!

Our goal is to collaborate with photographers to create captivating imagery that will showcase your property and increase its appeal to travelers. All styling and cleaning should be done before their arrival to ensure they can focus on creating great content.

Turn off all lamp lights. This will help your home feel inviting and clean.



Open all blinds, shades, and curtains to help bring in natural light and reveal external views.



Remove towels, stuffed animals, bed runners, flowers, and any other additional decorative items from beds.



Remove cluttered items from any tables, countertops, and other surfaces. This will help rooms look spacious.

### Exteriors & Backyards



#### **Exteriors**

Remove cars from driveway and hide unwanted objects (gardening hose, toys, tools). Tidy up any decorations or plants near the front door.



### **Backyard & Outdoor Areas**

Remove any unwanted items and tidy up area. Set up tables, umbrellas & chairs as if a guest will use them. Make sure all furniture & umbrellas are opened. Remove BBQ and/ or pool covers. Turn on overhead rope lights, safely ignite fire pits, etc.

### **Living & Dining Rooms**

Turn off all the lights, open curtains and blinds. Fluff pillows and smooth out cushions & blankets. Arrange decorative objects on all tables and shelves. Light fireplace & turn off the TV. Position dining room chairs symmetrically. Tidy tables, counters, and other surfaces.



#### **Kitchens**

Turn off all the lights, open curtains and blinds. Clean countertops and hide visible wires. Display a few top kitchen amenities of your choosing on countertop (e.g. espresso machine, sparkling water machine, toaster oven,). Place all cooking ingredients inside cabinets/on shelves. Arrange visible objects symmetrically (hanging pans, stools)

### Bedrooms & Bathrooms



#### **Bedrooms**

Turn off all the lights, open curtains and blinds. Remove towels, stuffed animals and bed runners from bed. Tuck in/check that the comforter is even at floor level. Fluff pillows (include two pillows per sleeper)
Clear bedside table, dresser, and desks of clutter.



#### **Bathrooms**

Turn off all the lights, open curtains and blinds. Arrange toiletries & hang towels neatly. Replace new toilet paper roll and put the toilet seat down. Open shower curtains/door. Clean surfaces (mirrors, glass doors, handles, etc.) If you have accessible amenities, such as a shower chair, please put them in place

## Publishing

Quick overview on what to avoid and what we would love to see



### **Curating and Captions**

Once your home has been photographed, our team will edit and retouch the photos. We'll then upload directly to your listing page, replacing the old images into a curated home tour.

From there, you will be able to rearrange and customize the order of the images. We recommend keeping the order uploaded by our editors.

Captions can be included for each image and are a great way to share additional context. Ideally, captions should be less than 140 characters and only focus on details that are not visually obvious.

### **Highlight Accessibility Features**

Highlight any accessibility features in your space—like a flat path to the entryway or a wide bathroom door frame that's 32 inches or more.

Similarly, if you have items like ramps, grab bars, or other accessible amenities, be sure to mention you have them available.

#### Example:

"Step-free bathroom with sturdy grab bars and non-slip shower mat. We can provide a shower chair upon request."



### **Contextualize Layout**

It's not always clear to guests where each room fits into a floor plan, so captions can help provide more context and further explain features that aren't visible in the photo.

### Example:

"Bedroom 1 (2nd floor) has a comfortable memory-foam mattress, Egyptian cotton sheets, and an ensuite bathroom."



#### **Call Out Features & Amenities**

Be clear that features displayed in the photo are available to your guests—like a kitchen in a shared home or a jacuzzi in the backyard.

### Example:

"Functioning kitchenette with stove, microwave, and coffee maker within your private room."
